**PSALM RESPONSE:** Here I am, Lord; I come to do your will.

**GOSPEL ACCL:** Alleluia, Alleluia!

We have found the Messiah:

Jesus Christ, who brings us truth and grace. Alleluia!

GOSPEL: As John stood with two of his disciples, Jesus passed, and John stared hard at Him and said, 'Look, there is the Lamb of God.' Hearing this, the two disciples followed Jesus. Jesus turned round, saw them following and said, 'What do you want?' They answered, 'Rabbi,' which means Teacher - 'where do you live?' 'Come and see' He replied; so they went and saw where He lived, and stayed with Him the rest of that day. It was about the tenth hour.

One of these two who became followers of Jesus after hearing what John had said was Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter. Early next morning, Andrew met his brother and said to him, 'We have found the Messiah' which means the Christ - and he took Simon to Jesus. Jesus looked hard at him and said, 'You are Simon son of John; you are to be called Cephas' -meaning Rock.

#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

- Part of the celebration of the Passover festival was the ritual sacrifice of many lambs so that the Jews could eat the Passover meal. In the story of Exodus, the blood of the lamb was shed so that it could be daubed on doorposts and thus enable the people to escape the angel of death. John recognizes that Jesus will be the one to give His life for the sake of all.
- 'Messiah' is a Hebrew word which mean 'anointed one'. 'Christ' is the Greek word meaning the same thing.
- A disciple is a person who follows a particular teacher & shares his or her views.

You called me."








## Be Ready to do God's Will

In today's first reading, God called young Samuel in a special way. Samuel's life had been dedicated to God, and because he was willing to follow God's plan, God made Samuel a holy prophet.

In the Gospel reading, Saint John the Baptist tells his followers that Jesus is the Messiah. Two of them decided to follow Jesus, and one of them, Andrew, went and got his brother Simon. When Simon went to follow Him, Jesus told him that his name would now be "Cephas," or "Peter," which means 'rock.' God had a special plan for Simon Peter. He was to become the leader of the Church- the first pope!

God does not call all of us to very important jobs like the prophet Samuel and Saint Peter. But each of us should follow Jesus and be ready to do His will. If we always try to do what God wants, then we will be ready if He does have a special job for us! How can you do God's will today?




Answer to front page: We have found the Messiah!
