PSALM RESPONSE: Lord, you have the words of everlasting life.

GOSPEL ACCL: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ, King of endless glory! God loved the world so much, He gave us His Only Son, that all who believe in Him might have eternal life. Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ, King of endless glory!

GOSPEL: Just before the Jewish Passover Jesus went up to Jerusalem, and in the Temple He found people selling cattle and sheep and pigeons, and the money changers sitting at their counters there. Making a whip out of some cord, He drove them all out of the Temple, cattle and sheep as well, scattered the money changers' coins, knocked their tables over and said to the pigeon-sellers, 'Take all this out of here and stop turning My Father's house into a market.' Then His disciples remembered the words of scripture: Zeal for your house will devour me. The Jews intervened and said, 'What sign can you show us to justify what you have done?' Jesus answered, 'Destroy this sanctuary, and in three days I will raise it up'. The Jews replied, 'It has taken forty-six years to build this sanctuary: are you going to raise it up in three days?' But He was speaking of the sanctuary that was His body, and when Jesus rose from the dead, His disciples remembered that He had said this, and they believed the scripture and the words He had said.

During His stay in Jerusalem for the Passover many believed in His name when they saw the signs that He gave, but Jesus knew them all and did not trust Himself to them: He never needed evidence about any man; He could tell what a man had in him.

Sacred Places

You shall Not make My FATHER'S HOUSE A HOUSE of TRADE! In the old times, people would bring animals to offer as sacrifices to God. By the time that Our Lord was born, there were people who were selling animals right in the area of the Temple. In today's Gospel reading Jesus drives the animals and money-changers out of the sacred space.

At one time the men who sold the animals for sacrifices were probably really helping the people who came to the Temple from far away. But now they were just trying to make money, and they were taking up space that was supposed to be used for people to worship God.

We also have sacred spaces like the Temple. Every Catholic church is a special place made for worshipping God in the Mass. We should always behave respectfully in church, and remember that Jesus is really there in the tabernacle. We can show our respect by walking quietly, not talking inside the Church unless it is



necessary, and by paying attention when Mass is going on. Maybe you can be a good example to your friends of how to act in church!
