I have told you this so that My own joy may be in you and your joy be complete. This is My commandment: Love one another as I have loved you. A man can have no greater love than to lay down his life for his friends. You are My friends, if you do as I command you. I shall not call you servants anymore, because a servant does not know his master's business; I call you friends because I have made known to you everything I have learnt from My Father. You did not choose Me, no, I chose you; and I commissioned you to go out and to bear fruit, fruit that will last; and then the Father will give you anything you ask Him in My Name. What I command you is to love one another."




What does Jesus ask us to do in today's Gospel reading?
